Steps for Placing an Order

Once you pay your deposit to the SANP, e-mail me to make an appointment.

Before we meet, make sure you have all of the items you would like to include in your quilt.

Count your items! Each graphic counts as on 1 item (front/back counts as 2 graphics). Be sure to count the items that you'd like to have made as well (dye sublimation or vinyl - each counts as 1 graphic).

If you would like a graphic made/recreated, try to locate the image that I will be creating (even a photo of the recipient wearing it helps).

Plan on the turn-around time. If you have a specific date you'd like your finished quilt, we will need to meet 4 weeks prior to that. The earlier you get your order in, the better!

- ☐ During our meeting, I will do my best to estimate the size of your quilt. When I am assembling your quilt, I may need extra items (optionals). If you have too many items, I will reach out to you and ask if you'd like to edit your collection or if you'd like to increase the size of the quilt.
- ☐ Photos of finished products may be used for marketing purposes. I will not tag you in any posts and I will not post prior to the recipient receiving their quilt.

Memory Quilt Fundraiser

Once you pay your deposit to the SANP, e-mail me to make an appointment. We can schedule a time to meet and plan your quilt. When we meet, I'll help you plan the colors of the fabrics/layout. Don't worry about having the order form filled out - we will do that together (you can fill out the personal information at the top).

Before we meet, make sure you have all of the items you would like to include in your quilt. I won't be able to start on your quilt until I have everything. You can include almost anything - jerseys, t-shirts, warm-ups, tech shirts, sweatshirts, sweaters, baby clothes, socks, rally towels, varsity letters, etc. Also consider the small graphics on sleeves, etc. Additionally, have a few shirts as 'optional' - I won't cut them up if I don't use them, but it helps to have a few extras to add if needed.

Count your items! Each graphic counts as one item (front/back counts as 2 graphics). Be sure to count the items that you'd like to have made as well (dye sublimation or vinyl - each counts as 1 graphic). If you would like a graphic made/recreated, try to locate the image that I will be creating (even a photo of the recipient wearing it helps). Think about the size of quilt you'd like to have made and try to match your collection to the estimated items needed per size (on the order form). During our meeting, I will do my best to estimate the size of your quilt. When I am assembling your quilt, I may need extra items (optionals). If you have too many items, I will reach out to you and ask if you'd like to edit your collection or if you'd like to increase the size of the quilt.

A note about the quilt label: I use a dye sublimation printer to print onto fabric and hand stitch the label onto the back of the quilt. You can include a photo(s) - baby, senior, family, pets, etc., an inspirational quote, a special note from you, etc. This is the last thing I do before delivering your quilt, so take some time to think about it prior to your quilt being completed.

Turn-around time: If you have a specific date you'd like your finished quilt, we will need to meet 4 weeks prior to that. The earlier you get your order in, the better! I have two college-aged kids and I know how hectic things get senior year!
